Com.Kawaljit Singh, Deputy General Secretary (Head Quarters) is retiring from our Bank's service on 31st August 2022 after serving for more than 37 years. He dedicated himself to the cause of the members with compassion and concern. Com.Kawaljit Singh, fondly called by all as 'Singh', though a Punjabi, was more a Tamilian since he was born and brought up in Chennai.

Com. Singh joined our Bank on 28.01.1985 at Sathanur branch. Later he was transferred to Zonal Office, Chennai in 1986. Com. Singh evinced keen interest in staff salary matters and gained much expertise and knowledge, which enabled him to solve issues related to fitment, ELOP etc., to benefit many of our colleagues, sub-ordinate staff in particular. He was part of the team that was formed when HRMS was rolled out, as he was thorough in HRMS related issues.

Com.Kawaljit Singh was a calm and composed person and a sharp observer too. He was promoted as Senior Assistant and posted to Commercial Branch, Chennai in April 2002. In June 2008, he was promoted as Special Assistant and transferred to Overseas Branch, Chennai. Wherever he worked, Com. Singh proved to be a supportive strength for the Unit Secretary. He was a committed organizer. In recognition of his invaluable service to the members, he was inducted into the Central Committee as Assistant Treasurer in June 2016. He was also chosen as a director of SBI Staff Co-operative Society and held the position of its Assistant Treasurer from 2012 to 2017. Com. Singh was always a frank and fearless person. He was a silent worker and would never prefer publicity. Calm leaders inspire more trust and perform better. Com. Singh always established himself as a strong man behind the scene, and would meticulously carry out any job entrusted to him with absolute perfection.

Com.Kawaljit Singh's knowledge of Hindi language came in handy when he headed the team formed to receive the leaders of other circles to take care of their stay and travel whenever they visit Chennai Circle for attending Organisational meetings and celebrations. He was the preferred choice of the leaders as he made them feel at home always. Com. Singh on promotion as Chief Associate, was again transferred to Commercial Branch, Chennai in June 2018. In July 2019 he was elevated as Vice-President of Chennai Zone I and in January 2022 he became DGS (HQ). He was also chosen as Council member of AISBISF in July 2022.

Com.Kawaljit Singh is blessed with a wonderful family. His wife Smt.Kamaljit Kaur worked as a school teacher. They have two daughters Nayna working for Zoho Corporation and Nethra working for Amazon and both are married. Their grand daughter Chakshu is 5 years old.
